Innovative design solutions have overcome the site constraints of this Hamptons/contemporary style home, to achieve the client's brief for a huge outdoor entertainment area on a small site. The home features a stunning living area that opens on three sides, so with a flick of a latch the space transforms into undercover, outdoor entertaining area. The 1.5m deep eaves above the bi-folding doors prevent summer sun from entering but allow winter sun to penetrate the building envelope and warm the exposed polished concrete slab. Privacy issues were resolved with dense native planting to the boundaries. The design has satisfied the lifestyle and comfort brief and will provide many years of enjoyable living and entertaining in this home.
